Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS) Report

Thank you to all involved in the recent SIAMS inspection. There are many from across the school community who helped leading up to the inspection and on the day. It was so encouraging to receive the positive feedback, in particular about our vision, links with the local church and schools and the pastoral heart of Highnam C of E Primary Academy.

Key Findings:

- The school has a distinctive Christian vision which enables children and adults to flourish with confidence. The creative interpretation of the vision for each year group, supported by excellent behaviour and relationships, ensures that children have the confidence to face challenges and do their best.
- Through collective worship and religious education (RE), children develop strong Christian values to guide them through life, and a deep sense of respect for those who may be different from themselves.
- The wide-ranging academic and pastoral support offered by the school allows all children to progress confidently to the next stage of their lives and learning.

A special mention must go to the groups of pupils who spoke to the inspectors on the day and were so proud to share their school and were fantastic ambassadors.
