Erasmus Update


It was good to catch up with our Erasmus partner schools in December. A big thank you to Leo, Ffion and Dexter who represented the school in sharing our Christmas traditions.

Thank you to those who have had birthdays in the last couple of months and have donated a birthday book to the class library.






Christmas Thank You
